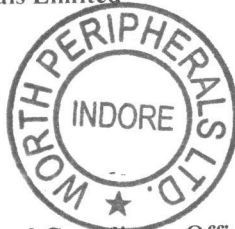

Linking Yoga, Ayurveda...

“Faith, region, religion, and gender don’t come in way of treatment. Hence, we need to pay attention to such kind of fallacy being created,” he remarked. Praising the role of the doctors, scientists and the central government during corona outbreak, he said there might be hardly 1% to 2% people who were not affected by the virus in some way or the other and everyone thought what would have happened had there not been scientists and doctors around. He said when a pandemic struck 100 years back, crores of people died but this time vaccines saved numerous lives. The vaccines provided by central government to some foreign countries saved lives over there too. “Given the pandemic, this time we all have to adopt a holistic approach on health and look ahead as to how to save ourselves if there is another pandemic,” he remarked. He said whereas India was becoming a medical tourism hub given the comparatively cheap medical facilities available here, the health services in the country needed improvement. The national health policy declared in 2017 aimed at providing quality health service to every person at reasonable cost. The goal need support from all - private and public sectors and people in general.

"Such acts of blatant human rights violations against innocent Kashmiris are aimed at denying Kashmiris their legitimate right to self determination. PM will not rest...

In the last eight years, pucca houses were provided to over three crore families; 10 crore families were saved from the ignominy of open defecation (by way of constructing toilets); nine crore women were saved from the adverse impact of smoke (by providing LPG connections); electricity connections were provided to 2.5 crore families and tap water connections were given to six crore families; over 50 crore people are entitled to get free treatment (under PMJAY insurance scheme), Modi said. “These are not just figures, but this is a proof of our commitment to provide dignity to the poor of the country,” he explained.

3 sisters, 2 of...

According to one media portal, Kalu Devi had to be hospitalised for 15 days after she was allegedly thrashed by her in-laws. She had reportedly sustained eye injuries and had just gotten back from the hospital. According to India Today's news portal, the three sisters were married off as children in 2003. The youngest sister was barely one-year-old at the time. But the three women wanted to earn their living and studied hard for it. Mamta had cleared the examination of police constable; Kalu was studying in BA final year, and the youngest sister, Kamlesh, was enrolled in a Central University.

Vivek Tankha to...

At present, there are 11 seats for Rajya Sabha from Madhya Pradesh, out of which 8 are occupied by BJP and three by Congress. The Congress had sent Tankha to Upper House in 2016. Tankha was one of the youngest advocate generals of Madhya Pradesh (16 February 1999 to 15 November 2003). Also, he was the first lawyer from Madhya Pradesh to have been appointed Additional Solicitor General of India. He played a major role in resolving disputes between Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh after the latter was created in November 2000.

Govt staff skipping...

Employees have sought leave from election duty citing ill health and have submitted their medical reports. After noticing a bunch of such applications, Rewa District Collector Manoj Pushp issued a circular mentioning: "Officials and employees who submit application of their ill health to skip election duty will be compulsorily retired under the rules of the government, which state the conditions: 20 years of services and 50 years of age."

MP police in...

In such cases, fingerprints can't be taken at police stations. Similar is the situation in jails which do not have any provision for recording fingerprints of the inmates – whether convicts or under trials. This means that even persons accused of molestation, stalking and outraging the modesty of a woman can now get away without recording their fingerprints. Those in the know of things say that the best way will be to make it compulsory for all accused to visit the police station at least once so that their fingerprints and other measurements can be taken. Directorate of Prosecution refused to comment on the issue.

Despite DMK opposition, TN third in NEET applications

While Tamil Nadu's DMK government and Chief Minister continue their stiff opposition to National Eligibility Cum Entrance Test (NEET), the number of students who have applied for the exam for medical college admissions has breached pre-Covid days. The number of students who have applied for NEET from Tamil Nadu has touched 1,42,286 applicants, 20 per cent more than that of 2021. This has crossed the 1.4 lakh applicants in 2019 just before Covid-19.

With this figure, Tamil Nadu ranks third in the number of applicants in the country with Maharashtra and Uttar Pradesh ranking first and second, respectively. Exemption from NEET has been one of the major election promises of the DMK and the party has passed resolutions in the Assembly towards this. Talking to reporters, Chennai entrance coaching institution owner Sudhir Raj said: “There is no option left for the students of Tamil Nadu other than appearing for NEET as the exemption has not been obtained.”

Seven cases of Omicron sub-variants in Pune

For the first time in Maharashtra, seven cases of Omicron subvariants BA.4 and BA.5 have been detected in Pune City. Whole genome sequencing (WGS) conducted by the state public health department in coordination with the B J Medical College, Pune, has revealed that four of the seven cases were BA.4 while the remaining three were BA.5, said the state public health department. “The new variant has been identified in WGS carried out by the IISER and has been confirmed by the Indian Biological Data Centre (IBDC), Faridabad. BA.4 and BA.5 are subvariants of the highly trans-

missible Omicron variant of the coronavirus. BA.4 and BA.5 are of the Omicron sublineage, which increases the rate of transmission of the virus to a 4 BA.4 & 3 BA.5 patients found between May 4 & 18; all mildly symptomatic, BA.4 and BA.5 have slightly increased transmissibility certain extent, according to international experience,” said the public health department. According to the public health department, all seven patients were from Pune City and the cases were detected between May 4 and 18, 2022. Four of the patients were male and three were female; four of them

were aged 50-plus, two in the 20-40 age group while one was a child less than 10 years of age. Two of the patients had a history of travel to South Africa and Belagavi, three had travelled to Kerala and Karnataka while two had no travel history. All but the nine-year-old are fully vaccinated, with one of them also having taken a booster shot. All of them were mildly symptomatic but did not need hospitalization and were treated successfully in home isolation. Surveillance Officer Dr Awate said “This is not, as such, a new variant. International experience shows there is a slight increase in transmission but not in the severity of the disease.

MINING LEASE CASE
Soren gets more time to appear before EC

NEW DELHI : Jharkhand Chief Minister Hemant Soren is learnt to have been given more time by the Election Commission to appear before in a case related to a mining lease. Soren was asked to appear before the EC either in person or through his counsel on May 31. But he sought more time and is now learnt to have been asked to appear on June 14, sources aware of the development said. His MLA brother Basant Soren is likely to appear before the poll panel on Monday in another case -- related to allegedly co-owning a mining firm.

CHENNAI: A 41-year-old man killed his wife and two young children allegedly with a portable electric wood cutter and then ended his life at his house in Pozhichalur at Pallavaram here, police said on Saturday. The gruesome deaths came to light when the neighbours, on suspicion, went up to the house and found the family of four lying in a pool of blood with their throats slit. Upon being informed, the Shankar Nagar police rushed to the spot and held preliminary enquiries. The horrid incident sent shock waves in the neighbourhood.

JAIPUR: The sports minister of Rajasthan Ashok Chandna, who wants to be free from a 'humiliating ministerial post' a day before has taken a turn on Friday night after a brief meeting with CM Ashok Gehlot and said 'CM is the guardian of Rajasthan Congress. Whatever decision he will take will be the right one.' Chandna was denied meeting with CM Gehlot on Friday afternoon but finally managed to meet late in the evening. The meeting lasts for hardly 10 minutes and following the meeting Chandna tweeted, 'there was

a meaningful and lengthy discussion on all subjects with Honourable Chief Minister. he is the guardian of the Rajasthan Congress family, whatever decision he will take be the right one. Bjp (has) to set its house in order. Congress is united and mobilised for mission 2023.' It was almost opposite of what he had tweeted on Thursday night when he attacked the principal secretary of CM, Kuldeep Ranka and said that he is relieved of the ministerial duties since Ranka was behaving like a minister of all departments.
