ED not voters...

Hinting that corruption over those 10 years had brought the Opposition under the scanner of Central investigative agencies, he taunted the opposition over its deep rifts. "The Enforcement Directorate did what the voters could not -- ED has brought all Opposition parties together on one platform," he said. Over the last nine years, instead of constructive criticism, compulsive critics have taken over, "those who feel that abusing Modi will solve their problems," he added in an arch reference to Rahul Gandhi's attack on Tuesday."Yesterday again in the Parliament, there was a discussion on Harvard," PM Modi then added, leaving no room for doubt about his target. "The Congress said India's destruction will be a case study at Harvard. However, in the past few years, Harvard did an important study. The topic was: The Rise and Decline of India's Congress Party. In the future, the destruction of Congress will not just be studied at Harvard but also at many other institutions around the globe," he added. Rahul Gandhi had accused the Prime Minister of having links with billionaire Gautam Adani, whose companies are in the spotlight after a damaging report by US-based short-seller Hindenburg Research alleged stock manipulation and accounting fraud by the group. He said the Harvard University of the US should focus on the situation. "Harvard University should study the relationship between politics and business - India is a case study and the Prime Minister should be given a gold medal for this," Gandhi had said in his first speech in Lok Sabha after his Bharat Jodo Yatra. The BJP said it was clear that Gandhi would make Gautam Adani the focus of the Congress campaign for the next election, and it would fail just the way their attack on the Rafale deal failed in 2019. "You are frustrated. But what can we do if the people won't vote for your party," said senior BJP leader and former Union Minister Ravi Shankar Prasad.

Lokayukta registers FIR...

Twenty-two cases have been registered against Thete when he was additional commissioner of Ujjain. A few other officers are co-accused in these cases. These cases are pending with the state government which has to give approval for prosecution. The present status of the cases is not known.

SIT formed to...

According to Sanghi, a team has begun to search for the ringleader of the gang. The cops presented eight members of the gang to the Court and took them into remand for three days. RBI's parting shot?...

The monetary policy committee (MPC), however, was split as it raised the key lending rate or the repo rate to 6.50%: Four of the six members voted in favour of the move. Significantly, inflation remains a bugbear. "The stickiness of core or underlying inflation is a matter of concern. We need to see a decisive moderation in inflation. We have to remain unwavering in our commitment to bring down inflation," RBI Governor Shaktikanta Das said as he announced the committee's decision. India's annual retail inflation rate eased to 5.72% in December from 5.88% in the previous month, falling below the RBI's upper tolerance band of 2%-6% for a second straight month, though core inflation, which excludes more volatile food and fuel prices, was still running at 6.1%. Consumer inflation is projected to be at 6.5% in the fiscal year 2023 and 5.3% for the fiscal year 2024.

Delhi HC directs...

The central government had, subsequently, informed that a "compliance affidavit" has been filed and action taken by the platforms, including Facebook and Twitter. The plaintiff was represented by lawyer Ashish Dixit. While passing the interim order, the court had said the circulation of the video was in violation of several laws and irreparable harm would be caused to the privacy rights of the plaintiff. Therefore, an ad interim ex-parte injunction was warranted, it had said. The court had noted that the full court of the high court had itself taken cognisance of the incident on its administrative side and pursuant to a resolution, its registrar general had conveyed to authorities the need to take appropriate action for blocking of the video over all ISPs, messaging platforms as also social media platforms. "Bearing in mind the sexually explicit nature of the contents of that video and taking into consideration the imminent, grave and irreparable harm that is likely to be caused to the privacy rights of the plaintiff an ad interim ex parte injunction is clearly warranted," the court had said in its order.

SC quashes Rs 2 cr...

It also remitted the matter back to the NCDRC for fresh determination of the compensation amount. Respondent Aashna Roy visited the salon of the Hotel ITC Maurya, New Delhi in April, 2018 for hair styling so that she would have a clean and groomed appearance before the interview panel where she was to appear. Form SIT to assess role of NC, PDP in promoting 'Muslim separatism', demands Kashmir Pandits

JAMMU: Panun Kashmir, an organisation of Kashmiri Pandits on Wednesday demanded the constitution of an SIT to investigate the role of National Conference (NC) and Peoples Democratic Party (PDP) in promoting 'Muslim separation in J&K'. Addressing the media here, Dr. Ajay Chrungoo, the chairman of Panun Kashmir demanded the creation of Special Investigation Team (SIT) to investigate, assess and analyze the role of NC and PDP in the promotion and perpetuation of Muslim Separatism and Islamic fundamentalism in Jammu and Kashmir. He said, "We welcome the action taken by the J&K government headed by Lt. Governor against the illegal encroachments and constructions across J&K, particularly by top political bigwigs. "We ask both the leader-

ship at the helms of the governments in Jammu and Kashmir and Centre to recognise such corrupt and illegal activity not merely as acts of corruption but as acts of internal subversion. "The opposition by the recently designated and banned terrorist outfit TRF to the government actions against illegal encroachments and constructions and threats to government officials who participate in such activities only proves

Attachments of Praful Patel assets confirmed

ED'S PMLA PROBE INTO MIRCHI PROPERTIES

The Delhi-based adjudicating authority under the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA) has confirmed the Enforcement Directorate's provisional attachment of certain assets of the former civil aviation minister and senior NCP leader, Praful Patel, as part of its probe related to the late international drug trafficker Iqbal Mirchi's assets. Four floors belonging to Patel and his family at Ceejay House, including his 15th-floor residence, had been attached provisionally by the ED in July last year, which was confirmed by the adjudicating authority recently, ED sources said. Patel did not respond when the FPJ attempted to con-

tact him for his comments on Wednesday over confirmation of the attachment. The ED had questioned Patel in October 2019, as part of its enquiry into an alleged 2006-07 joint venture between his company, Millennium Developers Private Limited, and Mirchi, for the construction of the 15-storey commercial building. ED sources had maintained that he had denied any wrongdoing whatsoever and claimed that Memon and her sons got the two floors via court processes.

Chhawla gangrape: SC to set up new bench to hear review plea

NEW DELHI: The Supreme Court on Wednesday agreed to constitute a three-judge bench to consider a plea of the Delhi Police for review of its verdict acquitting three death row convicts in the gang-rape and murder case of a 19-year-old girl in Delhi's Chhawla area in 2012. A bench of Chief Justice DY Chandrachud and Justices PS Narasimha and JB Pardiwala was told by Solicitor General Tushar Mehta, appearing for the Delhi Police, that one of the accused acquitted by this court has recently slit a throat of a person. "What I am saying is that all these accused, who were acquitted are hardened criminals. Therefore, we are seeking review of last year's verdict", Mehta said, adding that a three-judge bench headed by the then CJ had pronounced the verdict.

SC restrains construction within core areas in tiger reserves

Rule applicable for Nat'l parks, wildlife sanctuaries also AGENCIES/ NEW DELHI The Supreme Court Wednesday restrained authorities from carrying out any construction within core areas in tiger reserves, national parks and wildlife sanctuaries. The apex court did not appreciate the setting up of zoos and safaris inside tiger reserves and national parks. A bench of Justices B R Gavai and Vikram Nath asked the National Tiger Conservation Authority (NTCA) to file a response explaining the necessity of having safaris in national parks. The top court was dealing with a matter raising issues such as alleged illegal constructions in tiger reserves and the establishment of a tiger safari in the buffer area of Corbett Tiger Reserve in Uttarakhand. "Until further orders we restrain the authorities from doing any construction within the core areas notified in tiger reserves, national parks and wildlife sanctuaries," the bench said. The bench was also informed about a report submitted by an apex court-constituted panel, Central Empowered Committee (CEC), in which it has asked the Union Environment Ministry to amend or withdraw guidelines related to setting up zoos and safaris within tiger reserves and wildlife sanctuaries to discourage the use of wildlife habitats for tourism activities which are non-site specific. CEC, in its report, has also said that approvals given for setting up zoos and safaris within tiger reserves and protected areas should be withdrawn forthwith. The bench said, "Prima facie we do not appreciate the necessity of zoos inside tiger reserves and national parks." CEC has said in the report that wildlife tourism through the establishment of safaris and zoos forms an important component of conservation efforts, including tourism connected with endangered species of wildlife in educating the masses. "But the location of such safaris and zoos shall not endanger the life of the natural population and ecotourism and wildlife education should not be at the cost of survival of the endangered species.

Teachers' scam: 'OMR sheets with special codes used in exam'

KOLKATA: The ED told a special PMLA court here on Wednesday that the OMR sheets with special symbolic codes besides just two questions in the entire answer sheet were used in the primary teachers' written examination which were "the root of the entire scam". Hearing on the bail plea of MLA and ex-president of Board of Primary Education Manik Bhattacharya, the ED counsel said that the candidates paying money for recruitment as teachers were asked to answer only those 2 questions with the special codes and keep the remaining questions unanswered.

SC collegium recommends appointment of CJs of Patna, HP, Gauhati, Tripura HCs

AGENCIES/ NEW DELHI The collegium, also having Justices S K Kaul and K M Joseph, met on February 7 and recommended the name of Justice Aparaesh Kumar Singh for appointment as the chief justice of the Tripura High Court. It recommended the appointment of Justice Sandeep Mehta as the chief justice of the Gauhati High Court. The collegium resolutions uploaded on the apex court website said that the office of the chief justice of the Patna High Court has fallen vacant recently, consequent upon elevation of Justice Sanjay Karol as a judge of the top court.

Coal scam: ED recovers Rs 1 cr from bizman's office in Kolkata

KOLKATA: The ED sleuths, probing the multi-crore coal-smuggling case in West Bengal, recovered Rs 1 crore from office of a Kolkata-based businessman after a marathon raid at his residence and office on Wednesday. Although the ED sleuths have refused to disclose the name of the businessman concerned, they said they have got specific clues that the money recovered from his office was part of the coal scam proceeds which the said business was supposed to divert to different channels. As per the latest report, the ED sleuths have detained the businessman.

Ker transgender couple blessed with baby

THIRUVANANTHAPURAM: A transgender couple in Kerala's Kozhikode was blessed with a baby at the state-run Medical College hospital, reportedly the first such case in the country. The good news was shared by the close friends of the couple on the social media on Wednesday, however the new 'parents' wished not to divulge the sex of the new born. The couple is in an elated mood and thanked all who stood with them during the testing times. For several months, Sahad and 21-year-old Ziya Paval were gearing up to embrace parenthood after Sahad, a trans man, halted his transitioning process to get pregnant. After long discussions and deliberations, the couple decided to opt for this.



Surrogate mother need not be genetically related to child, SC told

NEW DELHI: The Centre has informed the Supreme Court that surrogacy law says a surrogate mother may not be genetically related to the child born through the process. Justice Ajay Rastogi is hearing a clutch of petitions, including one challenging certain provisions of the Surrogacy (Regulation) Act, 2021 and the Assisted Reproductive Technology (Regulation) Act, 2021. The petition has contended these provisions directly infringe upon the right to privacy and are against the reproductive rights of women and also a contention has been raised, in one of the petitions, that both Acts fall short in fully addressing the essential goal of regulating surrogacy and other assisted reproductive techniques. It has been argued that the Surrogacy Act imposes a blanket ban on commercial surrogacy, which is neither desirable nor may be effective. The Central government said section 4(iii)(b)(III) of the Surrogacy Act prescribes that no woman shall act as a surrogate mother by providing her own gametes. The government clarified that a child to be born through surrogacy to the intending couple should be formed of gametes of the intending couple themselves: sperms from the father and oocytes from the mother.

K'taka Cong chief gets ED summons, daughter receives CBI notice

SHIVAMOGGA Karnataka Congress President D.K. Shivakumar said on Wednesday that he has been asked by the ED to appear before it on February 24 while his daughter, Ishwarya, has been served a notice by the Central Bureau of Investigation. He chided that the ED and the CBI were only meant for the opposition parties. The CBI has issued a notice regarding disproportionate assets to Ishwarya and directed her to submit various documents. Sources said that the agencies have completed the investigation and the CBI was making preparations to file the charge sheet.
